Parking

Pictona has multiple parking areas surrounding the facility. Please follow tournament signage and parking directions when you arrive.

AIRPORTS

Several airports provide convenient access to Pictona and the Daytona Beach area.

Airport	Distance to Pictona	Approx. Drive Time	Notes
<u>Daytona Beach International Airport (DAB)</u>	6 miles	About 15 minutes	Closest airport with easy access to Pictona and area hotels.
<u>Orlando Sanford International Airport (SFB)</u>	40 miles	50–60 minutes	Popular option with several low-cost airlines.
<u>Orlando International Airport (MCO)</u>	75 miles	About 1½ hours	Largest airport with the greatest selection of airlines and nonstop flights.
<u>Jacksonville International Airport (JAX)</u>	110 miles	About 2 hours	Good option for travelers from some regions.



Travel Tip

If several teammates are arriving at the same airport around the same time, consider sharing a rental car or rideshare. Coordinating transportation can significantly reduce the cost per person.



GETTING TO AND FROM PICTONA
